Partners in Education (PIE) is a program run by the Parent/Teacher/Student Association (PTSA) that form alliances with local businesses for the benefit of McCallum High School. Our Partners donate money, goods, services, etc. PIE shares resources with the Excellence Fund, which provides assistance to McCallum teachers' expenses. Donations to PIE are separate from booster, academy and other fundraising at McCallum. Our funds benefit academic programming and campus-wide projects.

Below are a few examples of how Partners have helped our school:

1. TV to display work and art for digital media and graphic design classes
2. Earphones to be used with computers for various classes
3. IPAD and case for controlling lights and sounds for the theatre
4. Dictionaries for ESL for a variety of languages including French, Arabic, Persian, Nepali and Kinyarwanda
5. Padlocks for ESL students to secure their lockers
6. Numerous supplies for Science Labs
7. Washer and dryer for the Life Skills class and the nurse (also benefitting many of the sports teams)
8. In-kind donations such as gift certificates to be used for faculty meeting and breakfasts for teachers and staff
